



# UNION AND PEACE CODE OF CONDUCT

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## **CAMERA** –

- Delegates must have their cameras turned on at all times during an open session.
- Delegates must avoid a background that might disrupt the diplomatic environment.
- Delegates can turn their cameras off only when authorized by the chair.

## **MICROPHONE** –

- Delegates are allowed to turn their microphone on only when recognized by the chair during an open session.
- Delegates can have the microphone on only during an unmoderated caucus.

## **CHAT** –

- Delegates must demonstrate a diplomatic behaviour and use diplomatic even *vía* chat.

## **CONDUCT** –

- Delegates must display diplomatic behaviour at all times.
- The use of cellphones is strictly prohibited during an open session and can only be used in case of emergency.

## **DRESS CODE** –

- The dress code for U&P is strictly formal. One will be expected to dress in suits (if male) or in equally formal clothing (if female).

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## **DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES** –

- Delegates who deliberately do not comply with the code of conduct will receive a warning at the discretion of the chair or U&P staff members.
- Delegates who chose to continue violating the code of conduct after receiving a warning will be required to leave the session.
